GOAL

Equip rural communities with safe, sustainable Recovery Housing.

HOW

TEAM APPROACH

We work closely with a range of professional organizations known for their quality of care and devotion to public service.

COMMUNITY-BASED

Currently at work in nine states: Montana, Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Kentucky, Georgia, North Carolina, West Virginia, and Ohio

BLENDED FUNDING

We leverage funds and resources from a wide range of federal, state, private, and faith-based entities.

ACTIONS

RECRUIT PARTNERS

Preferably local non-profits who before now have been unable to secure sufficient funds to provide housing.

ACQUIRE FUNDING

To cover construction, start-up, and day-to-day operating costs (the latter primarily through diversion from corrections departments).

BUILD FACILITY

At least one facility in each state within the next three years, each providing a complete Continuum of Care.

OUTCOMES

	AT INTAKE	YEAR LATER	CHANGE
Illegal Drug Use	41%	8%	-34%
Opiod Use	68%	4%	-65%
Homelessness	38%	5%	-33%
Employment	48%	82%	+35%
Rearrest	58%	8%	-51%
Incarceration	75%	13%	-62%
