THE USPSTF AGREES

Given the prevalence of SUDs in patients and the effectiveness of medications to treat them, the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force recommends that primary care providers screen all patients for SUDs. The Fletcher Group is funded by the Kentucky Opioid Response Effort (KORE) to help healthcare providers identify and treat SUD patients.
