
Covid-19 Substance Use Warning

The risks and barriers faced by those who use opiods and methamphetamines.

Risk.

Those using opioids and meth may be more vulnerable due to their effects on respiratory and pulomonary health.



Smoking.

COVID-19 can be a particularly serious threat to those who smoke cigarettes, marijuana, or vape.



Barriers.

There may also be significant barriers to getting healthcare.



Access.

Self-quarantine and other public health measures may disrupt access to MAT and other support needed by individuals with SUD.



Homelessness.

Thoses with SUDs are more likely to be homeless which creates unique challenges regarding virus transmission.



Stigma.

We must ensure that individuals with SUD are not discriminated against when and if a rise in COVID-19 creates additional burdens on our healthcare system.
