#### ADMINISTRATION

- Democratically run
- Manual or P&P

- House manager or senior resident
- Policy & procedures

- Org hierarchy
- Admin oversight of service providers
- Policy & procedures
- Licencing varies

- Overseen hierarchy
- Clinical & admin supervision
- Policy & procedures
- Licensing varies

#### SERVICES

- Drug screenings
- House meetings
- Self-help meetings encouraged

- House rules
- Peer-run groups
- Drug screenings
- House meetings
- Self-help and/or treatment services

- Emphasis on developing life skills
- Clinical services in outside community
- Service hours provided in-house

- Clinical services and programming provided in-house
- Life skills development

#### RESIDENCE

- Generally single-family residences

- Primarily single-family residences
- Possibly apartments or other dwellings

- Varies — all types of residential settings

- All types — often a step-down phase within center's continuum of care
- Possibly more institutional

#### STAFF

- No paid positions within residence
- Perhaps an overseeing officer

- At least one compensated position

- Facility manager
- Certified staff or case managers

- Credentialed staff
