With just a few key strokes, the user-friendly Search Tool scans all available recovery houses within or near your rural community and lets you narrow your search with easy-to-use filters.

DOUBLE-DUTY

Owners and operators who list their residence on the registry can take the additional step of signing up for our new Recovery Management System—the third leg of the RH Portal—that enables them to record daily operations with state-of-the-art efficiency. In addition to streamlining record-keeping, the tool can also be used to solicit and receive advice regarding all manner of RH best practices. (Although a fee will eventually be charged to access the system's full functionality, your first-year costs will be covered by the Fletcher Group RCOE.)
